

The Hollywood Code of Ordinances prohibits motor vehicles from parking on the sidewalk.

Obstructing the sidewalk with a vehicle impedes pedestrian traffic, including children walking to school or being pushed in a stroller and those with limited mobility, forcing them to walk in the street. Vehicles parked on the sidewalk also contribute to deterioration and damage of the sidewalk. You may not be aware, but the abutting property owner is responsible for repair of the damaged sidewalk.

Vehicles must be parked on a driveway or on the swale facing the same direction as the flow of traffic. Vehicles parked on the swale must display a valid tag and cannot be permanently stored. If your property does not have adequate off-street parking, please contact the Building Division at (954) 921-3335 for information about installation of additional parking space.
