



## PARK EAST CIVIC ASSOCIATION

### **Opening :**

Mayor Mara Giuliani and Chief of Police Scarberry wished the membership a Happy Holiday Season. Mayor Giuliani commented on the affordable housing proposal and the overcrowded schools of Hollywood. Chief Scarberry spoke on the need to replace the present Police Station building.
