

**PARK EAST CIVIC ASOCIATION MEETING
HOLLYWOOD POLICE STATION
DECEMBER 19, 2006**

PRESIDENT TOM LANDRY OPENED THE MEETING WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGEANCE AT 7:05 pm.

THE MINUTES OF NOV MEETING WERE READ AND ACCEPTED.
